

ID Anywhere™ Secures NYC Office Buildings

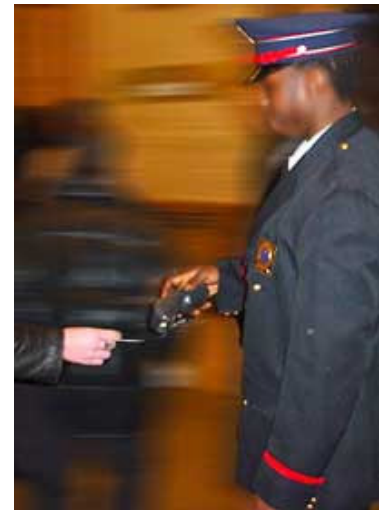

They can set up as many or as few entry points as they need, and can change each building's access configuration at any time. Fisher Brothers and Sandhurst provide ID cards to tenants who do not already issue them. Tenants with existing ID cards do not need a separate building ID.
